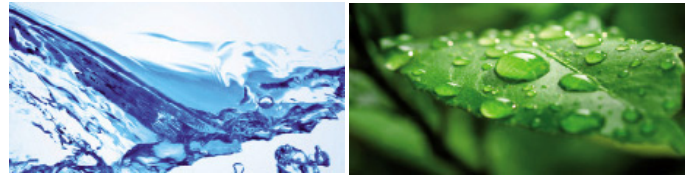

Renaë has over a decade of experience in project management and provision of corporate advice, flora and fauna survey, statistical analysis and survey sampling design.

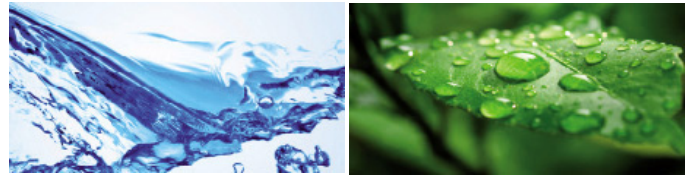
